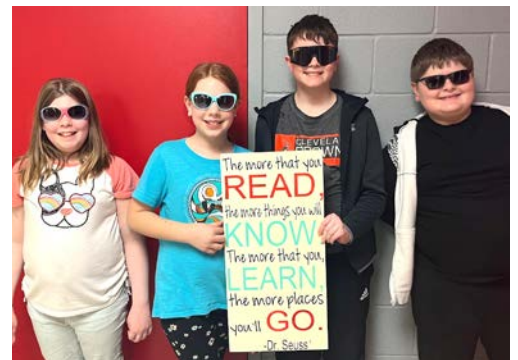

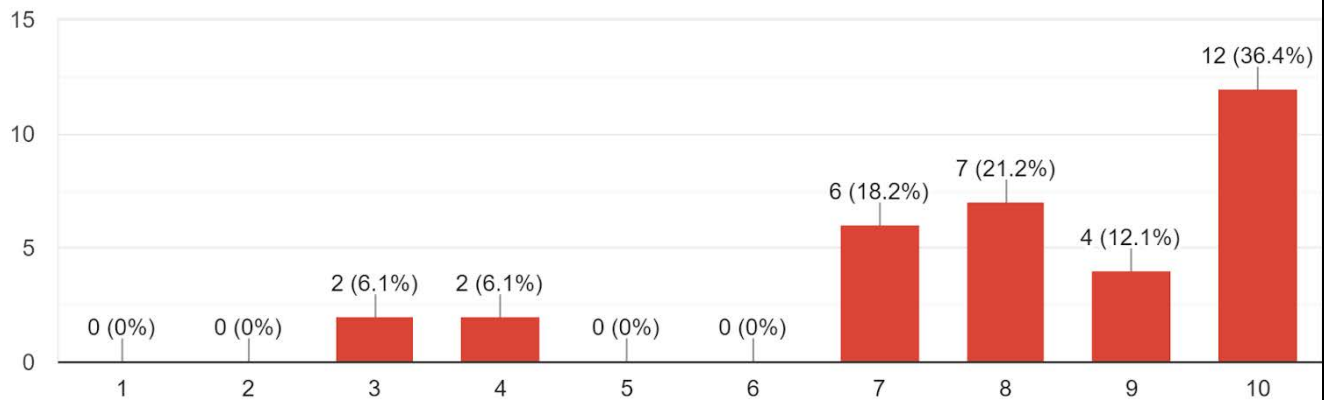

2022-23 PARENT SATISFACTION SURVEY RESULTS

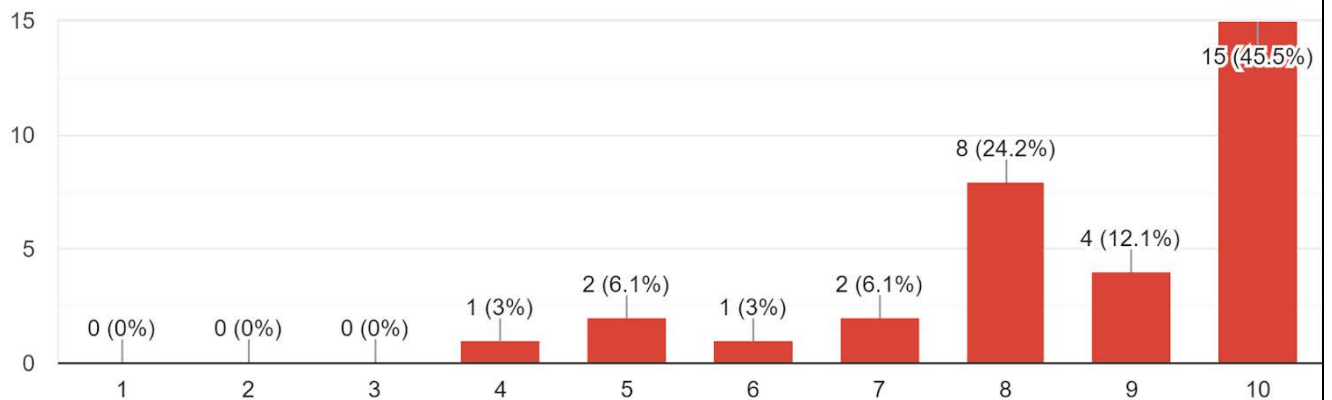
Please rate your satisfaction with the academic progress your child has made so far this year:

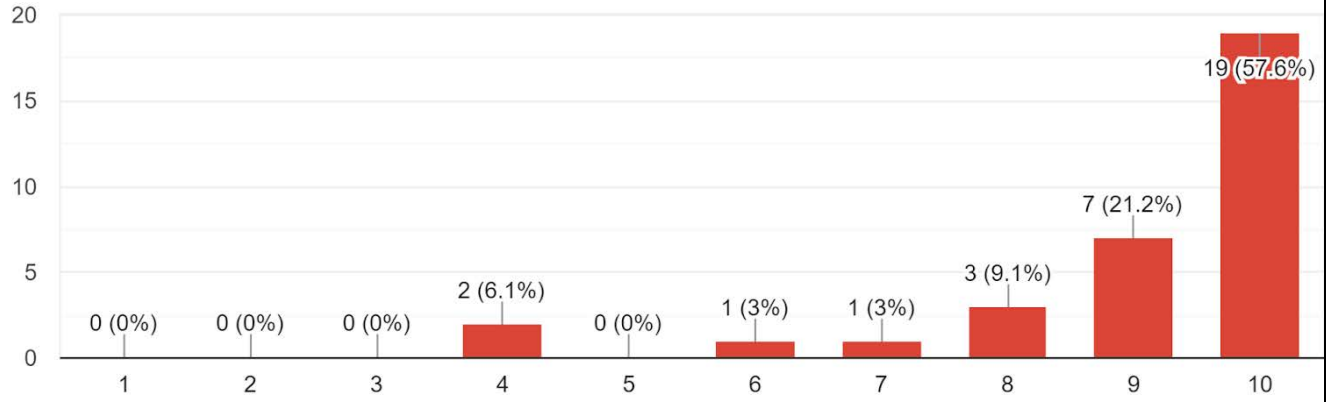

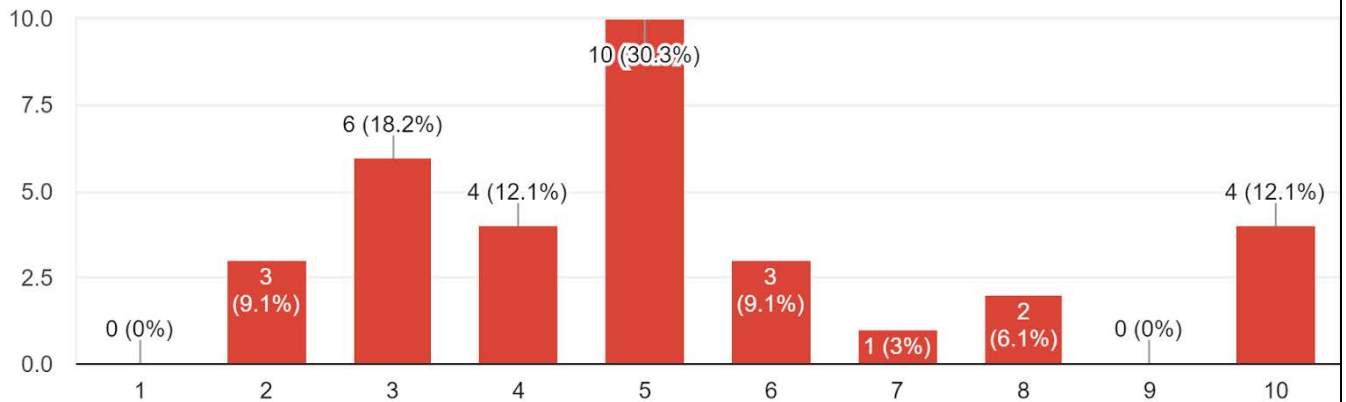

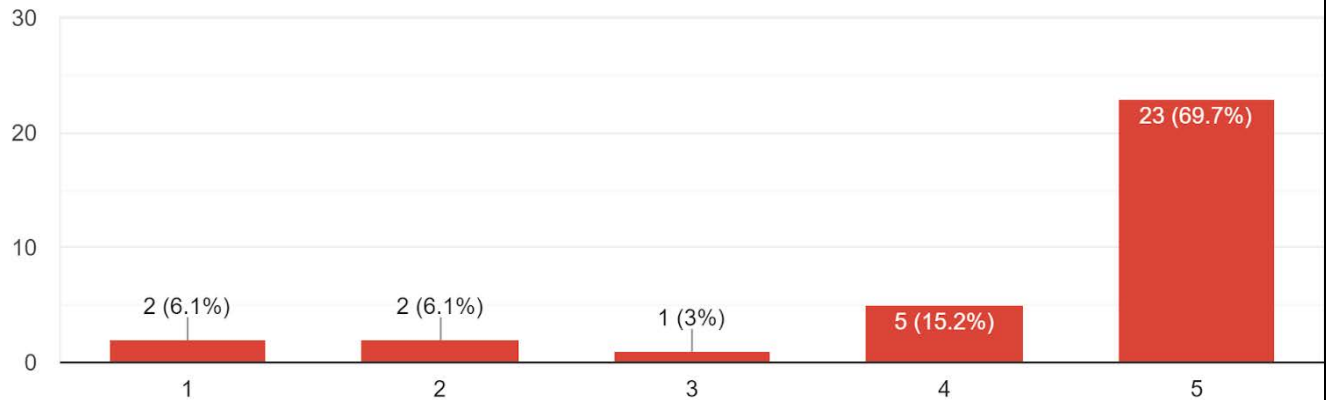


My child has no homework in an average week

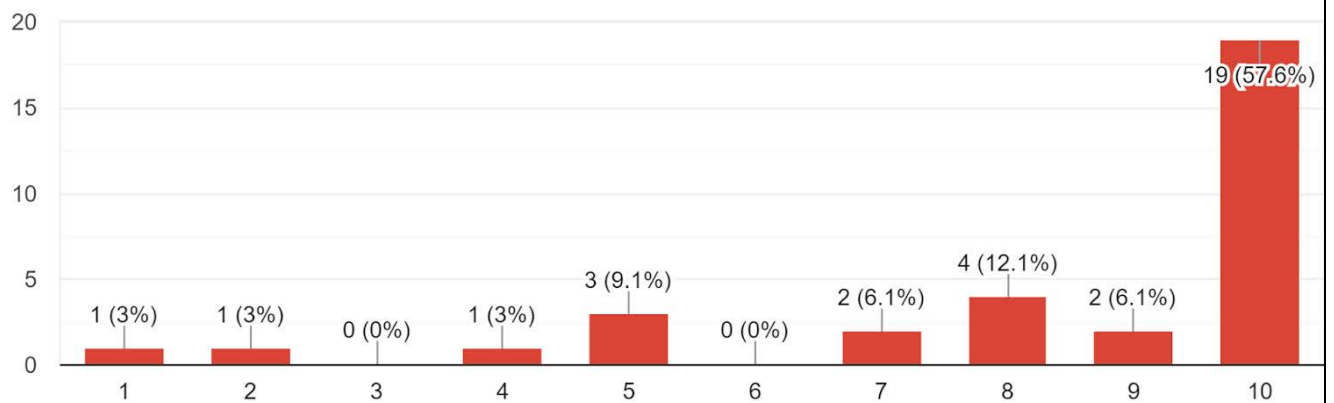

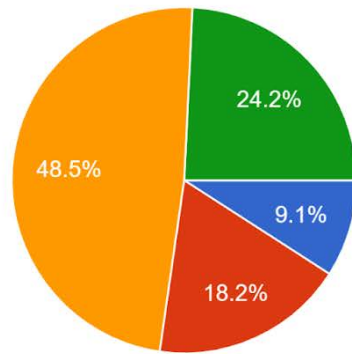

When considering Solomon compared to neighboring public schools, how do you believe your child's education compares:

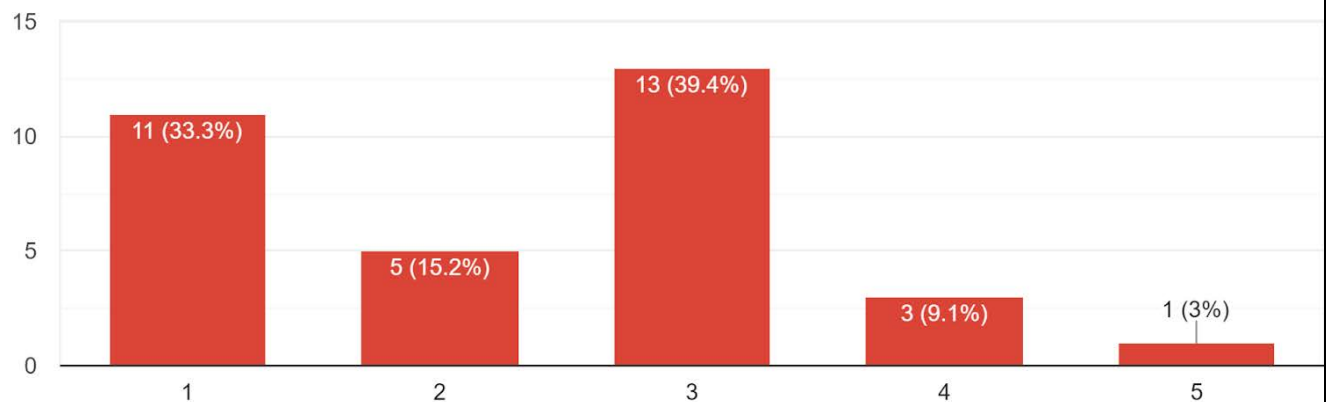

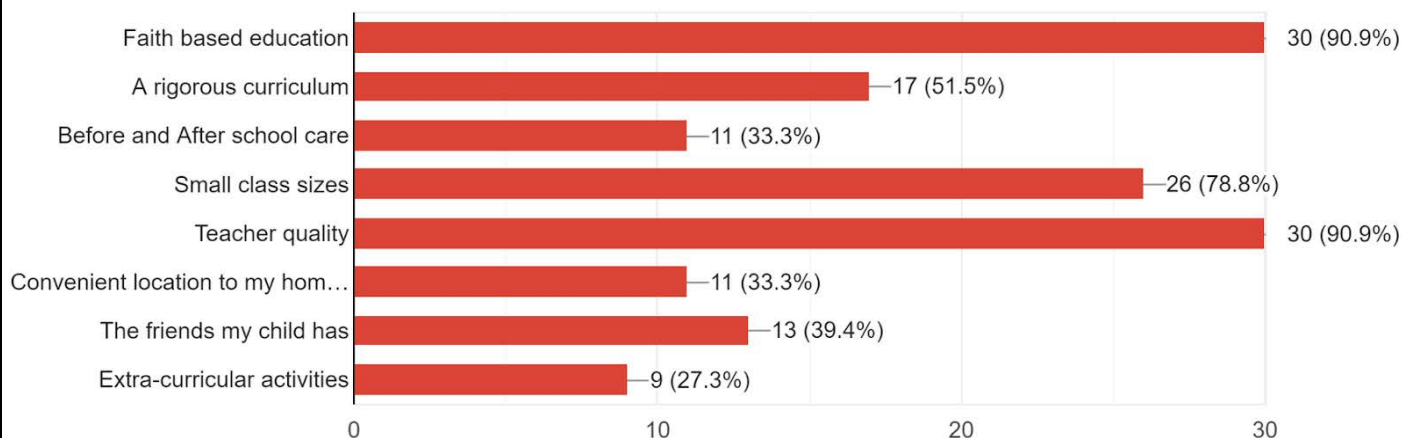
